

1 Minutes of the special meeting of the City Council held  
2 January 4, 1988 at 12:00 noon at the City Hall, Bountiful, Utah.

21 Mayor Stahle welcomed those in attendance, recognizing that  
22 Councilman Sharp will be leaving the Council. He also recognized  
23 newly-elected Councilman Gramoll and Councilwoman Holt.

25 At the invitation of the Mayor, Councilman Sharp expressed  
26 his feelings regarding the past four years' experience as a City  
27 Councilman, noting that he had gained a deep appreciation for the  
28 people who run the City (department heads and staff) and for the  
29 problems which face City government. He then wished the newly-  
30 elected councilpersons well in their responsibilities.

32 Mr. Jenson administered the Oath of Office to Mrs. Holt, Mr.  
33 Gramoll and Mr. Shafter, and Mayor Stahle welcomed the two newly  
34 elected members of the Council. Councilman Shafter reviewed his  
35 experience of the past four years and expressed appreciation for  
36 the other members of the Council that he had worked with. He then  
37 paid tribute to the late Bob Carlson, stating that "he lived the  
38 Water Department", as do other department heads in their respective  
39 responsibilities. He recognized Councilmen Sharp and Lawrence for  
40 their contributions and thanked the citizens of Bountiful for the  
41 opportunity which he has to serve them.

43 Councilwoman Holt expressed appreciation to the citizens who  
44 have placed their trust in her and said that she feels Bountiful  
45 is a good place to live. A resident of over 24 years, she said  
46 that she is pleased to have an opportunity to give back to the  
47 community a little of what she has taken.

49 Councilman Gramoll said he feels that it is a privilege to  
50 serve and he expressed appreciation to those friends who have  
51 worked on his behalf. He said that he is proud to live in  
52 Bountiful and to serve on the Council and affirmed that he wants  
53 to serve everybody.


1 Councilwoman Southwick welcomed the newly elected
