

1 Minutes of the special meeting of the City Council held
2 November 9, 1988 at 7:00 p.m. prior to the RDA meeting at the City

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15 Official notice of this meeting had been given by posting a
16 written notice of same and an Agenda at the City Hall and providing

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20 Mayor Stahle called the meeting to order and led the pledge of
21 allegiance to the flag. Councilwoman Holt offered the invocation.

23 **CONSTRUCTION OF WHEELCHAIR RAMP AT**
24 **PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING APPROVED**

25 Mr. Hardy reviewed that the Circuit Court has put the City
26 under notice that a ramp for access by the handicapped is required
27 at the Public Safety Building. Two years ago this project was put
28 out for bid, and inasmuch as the bids which were received were too
29 high, the project was not done at that time. The low bid received
30 at that time was \$14,900.00.
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32 Workman Construction is presently replacing some concrete in
33 front of the Public Safety Building, and at the request of the City
34 Engineer, has submitted a bid to construct the concrete wheelchair
35 ramp. Their bid is \$4,900.00 for the ramp itself and and an
36 alternate of \$8,000.00 (aluminum) or \$4,000.00 (steel) for the
37 handrail. The Council discussed the proposal from Workman Construc-
38 tion and the need for the ramp. Mr. Hardy noted that this project
39 is not included in the budget; however, it could be funded from the
40 City Council Capital Improvement Contingency Fund. Councilman
41 Gramoll made the motion that the bid of Workman Construction be
42 accepted, with a steel handrail, in the amount of \$8,900.00. He
43 also recommended that handicapped parking be provided close to the
44 ramp. Councilman Barton seconded the motion which carried unani-

47 **PUBLIC HEARING SET TO VACATE PORTION**
48 **OF STREET IN BRIDLEWOOD ACRES, NO. 4**

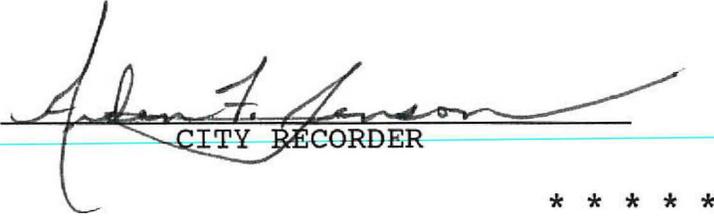
49 Mr. Hardy explained that one of the conditions of preliminary
50 and final approval of Bridlewood Acres No. 4 was that the proposed
51 extension of Bridlewood Drive be vacated. (He said that after the
52 subdivision was platted and subsequently reviewed by North Salt Lake
53 and the County, the street pattern was modified, thus necessitating
54 the street to be vacated). He reviewed the amended street plan and
55 recommended that a public hearing be set for December 7th at 7:30
56 p.m. to consider this matter. Councilman Barton made a motion that
57 the public hearing be set as recommended, Councilwoman Holt seconded
58 the motion and voting was unanimous.

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The meeting adjourned to the RDA meeting at 7:12 p.m. on a motion made by Councilwoman Holt and seconded by Councilwoman Southwick.
