

1 Minutes of the special meeting of the City Council held at
2 12:00 noon on January 6, 1986 in the City Hall of Bountiful,

22 Mayor Stahle welcomed those in attendance and called the
23 meeting to order. He reviewed activities which had transpired
24 in City government over the past four years and expressed
25 appreciation to the Council and staff for the opportunity of
26 working with them. He then invited comments from each council
27 member.

29 Councilman Hill said that he was pleased to have been a
30 part of the events of the past four years and noted that he
31 received a great deal of satisfaction from it. He expressed
32 appreciation to all those he worked with.

34 Councilman Lawrence noted that prior to serving on the
35 Council, he had had little experience with city government. He
36 said that he has gained a great deal of appreciation for the
37 quality and ability of the people who manage the City and that
38 Bountiful is fortunate to have employees of high quality.

40 Councilwoman Southwick said that it was a privilege to
41 commence another term as a councilwoman, noting that she has
42 served in this capacity for the past 12 years. She thanked her
43 husband for his loyal support and expressed appreciation to the
44 employees of the City and the other council members for their
45 contributions.

47 Councilman Sharp indicated that his role in government had
48 been rather passive prior to serving on the Council and that he
49 has developed a deep appreciation for the quality of service
50 which the community gets from the City staff and for the quality
51 of people who live in Bountiful.

53 Mr. Hardy expressed appreciation on behalf of the staff for
54 the opportunity of working with the Council and stated that we
55 feel we have the finest City Council in the State."

57 Mayor Stahle then requested that the newly elected persons
58 be sworn in and Mr. Jenson administered the Oath of Office to

1 Mayor Dean S. Stahle, Councilwoman Phyllis C. Southwick, and
2 Councilman H. Keith Barton. Oath of Office cards were signed
3 by these persons.

5 Mayor Stahle welcomed Councilman Barton and reviewed some
6 of the goals of the City for the coming four years. Councilman
7 Barton expressed appreciation to those who placed their con-
8 fidence in him through their vote and said that he is looking
9 forward to the next four years.

11 Councilman Sharp made a motion for adjournment at 12:35
12 p.m. Councilwoman Southwick seconded the motion which carried
13 unanimously.
