

MINUTES
OF
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
July 7, 1982

A special meeting of the City Council was called to order at 6:45 p.m. by Mayor Dean Stahle. Present were Councilmen Paul Allen, Phyllis Southwick, and Keith Barton.

The Mayor turned the time over to the Bountiful Lion's Club to make a presentation to the city. Paul R. Allen requested that Elmer Barlow review the proposed donation of the Lion's Club to the city. Elmer Barlow stated that the Lion's Club was desirous of donating a jacuzzi to the city, to be installed at the Recreation Center. The Lion's Club would be willing to donate \$6,500.00 immediately, and up to an additional \$2,000.00 in March of 1983. Paul R. Allen, President of the Lion's Club, stated that only two conditions were attached to the donation; first, a plaque recognizing the contribution of the Lion's Club should be installed in the room where the jacuzzi is located. Second, the Lion's Club wish to be the solo donor of the improvements.

The Mayor expressed his gratitude to the Lion's Club for the many contributions which they had made to the City of Bountiful over the years. Coy Hayward, a member of the Bountiful Lion's Club, reviewed some of the past improvements and donations that have been made.

Upon a motion by Paul Allen, seconded by Phyllis Southwick, the donation of \$8,500.00 from the Lion's Club for construction of a jacuzzi was approved unanimously by the Council.

There being no further business to be conducted, it was moved by Keith Barton, seconded by Paul Allen, that the Special City Council meeting be adjourned. The meeting adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
