

Minutes of the regular meeting of the City Council held November 9, 1994 at 7: 10 p.m.  
in the Council chambers of the City Hall, Bountiful, Utah, following a meeting of the Redevelopment Agency.

Official Notice of this meeting had been given by posting a written notice of same and an Agenda at the City Hall and providing copies to the following newspapers of general circulation: Davis County Clipper, Deseret News, and Salt Lake Tribune.

Mayor Cushing called the meeting to order and welcomed the visiting Boy Scouts. He reviewed information with the Scouts which will be helpful to them in completing their citizenship merit badge.

Minutes of the regular meeting of the City Council held November 2,. 1994 were presented and unanimously approved as corrected on a motion made by Councilman Moore and seconded by Councilman Shafter.

**EXPENSES AND EXPENDITURES APPROVED  
FOR PERIOD OCTOBER 26-27, 1994**

Mr. Jenson presented the Expenditure and Expense Report for the Period October 26-27, 1994 in the amount of \$249,725.32. Following a discussion by the Council, these expenditures were unanimously approved on a motion made by Councilman Moore and seconded by Councilwoman Holt.

**MAYOR RECOGNIZES REPRESENTATIVE-ELECT  
SHERYL ALLEN**

Mayor Cushing welcomed Sheryl Allen, newly elected State Representative. Mrs. Allen gave a brief response and pledged her desire to be responsive to the needs of the citizens. Mayor Cushing mentioned that he had also visited with Congressman to meet with the Bountiful City Council.

**COUNCIL ADOPTS ORD. NO. 94-18 RE: MASSAGE  
THERAPY LICENSING**

Mr. Mahan reviewed that the State adopted a Massage Practice Act in 1990 which stipulates the licensing requirements for message therapists. He reviewed Ordinance No. 94-18 entitled AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BOUNTIFUL CITY CODE TO PERMIT MASSAGE TECHNICIANS LICENSED BY THE STATE OF UTAH TO BE LICENSED IN BOUNTIFUL and recommended that the Council adopt this ordinance. Councilwoman Wilcox motioned to adopt the ordinance as presented and recommended. Councilman Shafter seconded the motion and voting was unanimous.

**PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER AMENDING  
ZONLNG ORDINANCE; ORD. NO. 94-19 ADOPTED**

At 7:30 p.m. Mayor Cushing opened the public hearing to consider amending the zoning ordinance as it relates to Temporary businesses and uses. Mr. Gehring explained that when the zoning ordinance was recently revised and adopted *temporary businesses* and *temporary uses* were combined under the same regulations. Inasmuch as these two matters are distinctly different and require different regulation, staff prepared changes to the ordinance which comes with a positive recommendation from the Planning Commission. (He noted that several details have been changed since the Planning Commission review and Councilwoman Holt stated that she felt the changes have improved the ordinance).

Mayor Cushing called for input from those in attendance. There was none and the public hearing was closed at 7:34 p.m.. Councilwoman Holt motioned for approval of Ord. No. 94-19 entitled AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 14-15-101, 14-15-102, AND 14-15103 (B) OF THE BOUNTIFUL CITY CODE RELATING TO TEMPORARY BUSINESSES AND USES. She also requested that the Planning Commission be apprised of the changes made by staff and the rationale for those changes. Councilman Moore seconded the motion and voting was unanimous.

**ORD. NO. 94-20 ADOPTED RE: TEMPORARY BUSINESS LICENSES**

Mr. Gehring explained that with the adoption of Ord. No. 94-19, it is the recommendation of staff and the Planning Commission that the business licensing section of the Bountiful City Code also be amended for clarification. He reviewed Ord. No. 94-20 entitled AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5-1-105(b) OF THE BOUNTIFUL CITY CODE RELATING TO TEMPORARY BUSINESS LICENSES and recommended adoption. Councilwoman Holt motioned for adoption of Ordinance No. 94-20, Councilman Shafter seconded the motion and voting was unanimous.

**MISCELLANEOUS**

Two of the Boy Scouts in attendance questioned the Council regarding the **legality of snow sledding** on the hill east of Mueller Park Junior High School. Mr. Hardy explained to them the area which is owned by the City (the eastern portion of the hill) and he said that the area by the backstop has been posted to prohibit sledding in an attempt to prevent accidents. He said that it is okay to sled on the upper hill or away from the backstop.

Mayor Cushing expressed **appreciation to Mr. Mahan and Mr. Barneck** for the many weeks of preparation prior to the recent trial regarding annexation.

Councilman Shafter requested an **update of the traffic** situation as it relates to the LDS temple open house. Mr. Hardy stated that all is going well and that there has been very little traffic congestion. Councilman Shafter requested that a letter of appreciation be sent to the State road department for the directional signs which have been placed on the freeway.

Councilman Moore noted that a number of agencies sponsored a workshop in Park City for the purpose of developing an action statement regarding **social problems in the community**. Additional information on this matter will be forthcoming.

At the request of Mr. Hardy and with concurrence of the committee members, the following **committee meetings were scheduled:**
